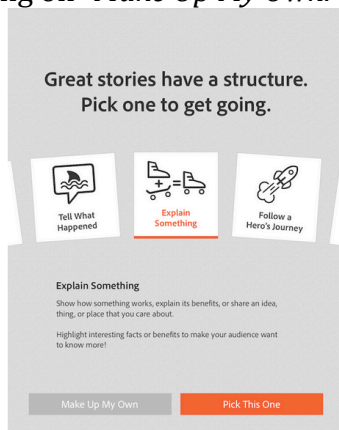


Adobe Voice in the Classroom

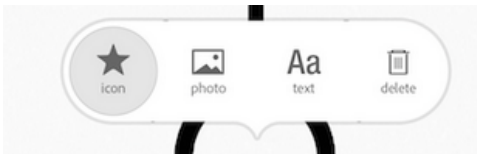


Adobe Voice allows students to create digital stories, explanations or presentations by adding their voice to a variety of images.

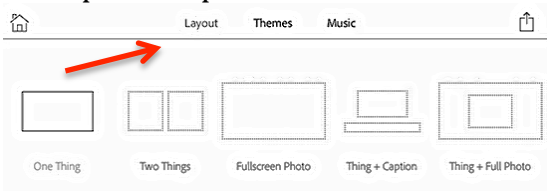
1. **Create:** Tap “+ Create a New Story”
2. **Title:** Give your project a title or a short description then press “Next.”
3. **Story Structure:** Scroll through the different options to find one that fits your need. Tap on the one that you want and tap “Pick This One.” If none of them fits your need, you can create a custom one by tapping on “Make Up My Own.”



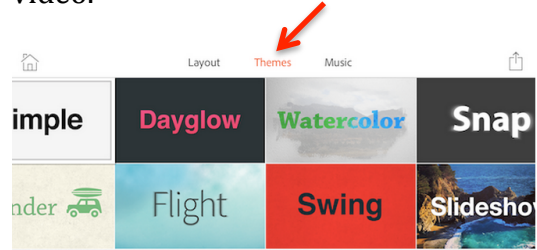
4. **Voice Recording:** To record your voice, tap and hold on the orange microphone icon.
5. **Add Images/Text:** Tap on the “+” in the center of the page to add icons, photos or text.



6. **Page Format:** Tap “Layout” in center of the top bar. Tap on a format to select it.



7. **Theme:** Tap “Themes” at the top of the screen to pick a main theme for your video.

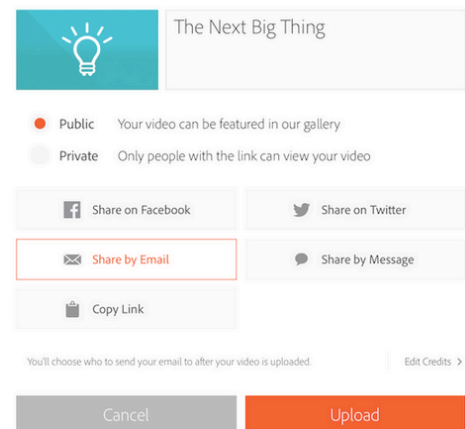


8. **Preview your video:** Tap the play button on the bottom left corner of the screen. This will open your video in full screen.



9. **Share your video:** Tap the share button on the top right. Change the setting to private or public. Share it on Facebook, email, Twitter or Message.
